### Easter Jubilee

As we begin our Easter Jubilee — fifty days of celebrating the unfathomable proclamation of Jesus' resurrection — the Church invites us to ponder anew the cosmic significance of Jesus Christ crucified raised from the dead. Not a vague recollection of a past event, Jesus' death and resurrection continues to unfold within each of us as we embrace the Gospel truth that out of death comes life. Here is the plan of salvation actively germinating within the hearts of humankind — a seed that will bear fruit in God's Kingdom as we nurture and tend to its growth in our daily lives. This is either true or false. It cannot be somewhere in the middle. If it is true, then our very lives are at stake; if it is false, then it doesn't matter what we do. If it is true, then we bow down in worship before the God who has revealed such a marvelous truth to us. If it is false, then we shouldn't bother with anything other than ourselves. Words will not convince anyone of the Gospel's truth. Lives lived according to the Gospel, however, will give others the opportunity to choose the truth because they see it in our very flesh.




#### **Steubenville Youth Conference**

Steubenville High School Youth Conference is going to be held at St. John's University, Queens, NY, July 19<sup>th</sup>—21<sup>st</sup>. The goal of every Steubenville Conference is for teens to open their hearts to Jesus Christ who desires their lives to be fulfilling, exciting, and joyful! Mass is celebrated daily and the Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered during the weekend, as well as Eucharistic Adoration on Friday and Saturday. It is during these times that many teens come to experience the love of the Lord, and the need they have to either commit or recommit their lives to Him.

Our parish anticipates sending more than 25 teens and leaders to the conference! To support this effort, however, each teen must raise \$350 to cover costs (room, board, registration fee) in addition to hiring a bus. Each teen is responsible for acquiring the funds.
